GUESS MY STATE: HOW TO PUT YOUR TRACT TOGETHER AND SHARE JESUS

- 1. Print the two pages of the tract so that they are on one page-front and back. This is a free tract to print and use. Print as needed.
- 2. Cut out the pages by cutting on the 5 dark lines.
- 3. Arrange the pieces like this:



The page at the top goes on top of the next and then that one on top of the next...Like in the pictures.



4. Put them together in order. The page numbers are lightly placed so you can make sure. Fold down the middle to make the booklet.





- 5. Staple together on fold. You may have to gently bend some of one side over to fit if you only have a regular sized stapler. If you do this, make sure you smooth and flatten the pages back out after stapling.
- 6. Get to know the scriptures and practice sharing Jesus with your church friends. Then take this tract and share with someone. When you share, pray and read it with them if they need help. Trust God with the results, don't force anything. Follow-up if you know the person. You might ask later if they've thought about it more. Another time, you might ask if they have a Bible. Another time, invite them to church... Finally, offer them an opportunity to recieve Jesus as their Lord and Savior...this could be on the first day or later if the Holy Spirit shows you that you need to wait. A true, repentant heart is the best test to see if they are ready. If there is no conviction of sin, let God convict them. To see if they are repentant, check to see if they believe they themselves are a sinner. Then ask if their sin makes them sad when they realize they have broken God's laws. If someone thinks they are good enough without Jesus, they are not ready. As you prepare, ask God to help you truly care about the state of everyone's soul...not just friends, but even people you don't like...and those you don't know!






